### MOTION FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENT

Comes now the Petitioner, West Virginia Board of Accountancy, pursuant to Rule 55 of the West Virginia Rules of Civil Procedure, and move for a default judgment against Respondent, David Allen Aleshire. In support of such motion, the Petitioner states as follows:

- 1. This action is an injunction against the Respondent for holding himself out to be a Certified Public Accountant.
- 2. The Petitioner has sent several notices to the Respondent prior to filing this action, however the Respondent failed to acknowledge any of the Petitioner's notices.
- 3. This Court entered an order granting Petitioner additional time to perfect service.
