CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, the West Virginia Board of Accountancy has instituted a Complaint, Case No. 2002-01, against John D. Blair, Jr., License No. WV001178; and,

WHEREAS, the parties desire to resolve said Complaint, it is hereby agreed that the Complaint will be dismissed with prejudice upon the following terms:

1) That Mr. Blair will complete a continuing professional education course relating to ethics or management of accounting practice by the end of 2003;

2) That Mr. Blair will provide evidence of his successful completion of the continuing professional education course as described in paragraph 1.


3) That this case may only be reopened based on a failure of Mr. Blair to comply with the requirements of paragraphs 1 and 2;

4) That Mr. Blair specifically denies that he has engaged in any conduct discreditable to the accounting profession and that this Consent Order is merely a resolution of a disputed claim;

5) That Mr. Blair and the Board agree that this Consent Order is not to be considered or construed to be a disciplinary action, censure, admonishment, reprimand,

suspension or any type of sanction of any form.

WHEREFORE, on this 12~~th~~ day of September, 2003, as evidenced by the signatures below, Complaint Case No. 2002-01 is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
